The Community Engagement/Board meeting was opened at 6:00 PM by President Osterloh. Members present: Habrock, Kerans, Derby and Osterloh. Board member Habrock made a motion to excuse member Laughlin; seconded by Derby. Members voting aye: Habrock, Kerans, Derby and Osterloh. Members voting no: none. Motion carried 4-0.
