FALL LEADERSHIP CONFERENCE

Students from Louisville will be attending the SkillsUSA Fall Leadership East Conference in Lincoln, NE. The conference was host to over 250 students from across the state, and was held at Southeast Community College in Lincoln. The conference focuses on introducing students to SkillsUSA, activities to develop leadership skills through organized training, and also connecting students with business & industry partners through professional employability sessions. Students who attended the conference will be empowered and energized to return to the Louisville chapter with tools to enhance student leadership and workforce readiness skills.

MID-AMERICA CONFERENCE

Students from the Louisville Chapter will be attending the annual Mid America Conference on October 18th -21st, 2018. This conference features students from eight different states coming together for SkillsUSA's second oldest conference, which focuses on leadership, officer training and chapter development. The Mid America Conference is held annually in Columbus, NE.

Each year over 200 students attend the regional event. The focus of the conference is officer training and developing leadership skills among SkillsUSA student members. During the four day conference, students are placed into individual chapters, working with students from other chapters and states to complete the SkillsUSA Program of Work. The Program of Work is the activities and projects—the plan of action—that a chapter will carry out during the school year. The program of work includes professional development, community service, ways and means (fundraising), public relations, social activities and also the SkillsUSA Championships (competitions).
