Dear LEA President and all members of the Louisville Education Association.

The Louisville Board of Education has adopted policy 3057 regarding Title IX, the prohibition against discrimination on the basis of sex, and grievance procedures for complaints. This policy may be found on our website at: www.lpslions.org It is also attached to this email. At the future revision, this policy will be published in our employee handbooks, distributed to all employees.

Pursuant to this policy, the district does not discriminate on the basis of sex in any education programs, which extends to admission and employment. Inquiries about the application of Title IX and 34 C.F.R. part 106 to the district may be referred to the district's Title IX Coordinator, the assistant Secretary for Civil Rights of the United States Department of Education, or both.
