District Policy: 3057 *Title IX Procedures*

It is the policy of Louisville Public Schools, that no person shall, on the basis of sex, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subject to discrimination under any of the Educational Service Unit #3 programs or activities. Louisville Public Schools and Educational Unit #3 are required by Title IX (20 U.S.C. § 1681) and 34 C.F.R. part 106 to not discriminate in such a manner. This non-discrimination policy extends to admission and employment, and inquiries about the application of Title IX and 34 C.F.R. part 106 to the Louisville Public School district or educational service #3 agency may be referred to the Louisville Public School district’s or educational service agency’s Title IX Coordinator, the Assistant Secretary for Civil Rights of the United States Department of Education, or both.
