Special Budget Hearing/Tax Asking Hearing/Special Meeting
August 30, 2021
6:00 PM

Board President Winkler opened the budget hearing at 6:00 PM for any public input regarding the proposed 2021-2022 budget as presented. President Winkler asked for a moment of silence in respect for the U.S. Service men and women that were killed in Afghanistan last week. Roll call for attendance. Members present: Mixan, Simon, Habrock, Osterloh, and Winkler. Motion by member Osterloh to excuse member Christiansen; seconded by Simon. Members voting aye: Mixan, Simon, Habrock, Osterloh and Winkler. Members voting no: none. Motion carried 5-0. Member Christiansen entered the meeting at 6:07 PM.

Notice of the hearing and where the agenda was made available for public inspection had been posted in four places and published in the Plattsmouth Journal and Omaha World Herald prior to the hearing per Board Policy.

Superintendent Farber presented the 2021-2022 proposed budget to the board and audience. Discussion was held.

President Winkler closed the Budget hearing at 6:32 PM and opened the Hearing to set the Final Tax Request.

Superintendent Farber presented the 2021-2022 Final Tax Request to the board and audience. A comparison from the 2020-2021 Tax asking to the 2021-2022 Tax request was shown. The district is lowering the levy from 1.167252 to 1.156499.

As there were no questions regarding the Final Tax Request, President Winkler closed the Hearing at 6:34 PM and advised the board and audience that they would take a break in the meeting until 7:00 PM to allow for more patrons to attend the conversation pertaining to the back-to-school plan.

The meeting resumed at 7:00 PM for presentation and discussion of the back-to-school plan. Superintendent Farber advised the audience and board that data regarding Covid cases in the district will be accessible on the lpslions.org website. It was asked if more data can be accessed on that site, Mr. Farber said he would check in to it. After the meeting concluded, Board member Mixan thanked the audience for attending and for a congenial discussion recognizing that different opinions had been shared but that all had the health and wellness of the district at heart. Several audience members thanked the board for their efforts acknowledging it is a difficult time to be a board member.
