Louisville School Foundation 2023 Scholarships

- Earnest & Gladys Henning's Scholarship - Two (2) \$500 Scholarships. It is a need- based scholarship, not to be awarded to top-ranked students. Looking for hard working students likely to be successful in college, with good character and work habits.
- Matthew Meisinger Memorial Scholarship - One (1) \$500 Scholarship. Prefers a student planning on pursuing a vocational education of any kind (for example, mechanical/construction trades, technology, healthcare (including nursing), etc. Must be a hard-working student with firm career goals.
- Lando & Eleanor Baker Scholarship - One (1) \$500 Scholarship. It is a needs-based scholarship for a student entering a technical field such as architecture, engineering or computer science.
- Harry & Selma Johnson Memorial Scholarship - Two (2) \$500 Scholarships. It is a need- based scholarship given to a student who demonstrates good character and work habits but may not

be a top ranked student by GPA.

- John W. Plucknett Leadership Scholarship - Recipient should be a student who meets at least 4 or the 5 following criteria points: The student exhibits outstanding leadership skills in the school setting, a good community service (of any type) record, a grade point average of 91 or above, the student was an athlete or involved in extracurricular activities, and the student is interested in majoring in business or finance.
- Robert Wiesneth Memorial Scholarship - One (1) \$500 scholarship. Given to a "top" student that has taken a heavy class load of college prep advanced and online classes (physics, advanced biology & English, pre-calc.). Preference given to students that can maintain a high GPA, while being involved in school or non-school activities.
- Outstanding Senior Scholarship - One (1) \$500 Scholarship. Selected by teacher vote.
- Suzanne Pankonin-Lindahl Memorial Scholarship - One (1) \$300 Scholarship. Awarded to any senior student based on the merits of their application form as selected by the board of the Louisville School Foundation.
- Louisville School Foundation Scholarships - \$300 Scholarship. Awarded to any senior student based on the merits of their application form as selected by the board of the Louisville School Foundation.
- Louisville School Foundation ACT Scholarships - \$300 Scholarship. Awarded to any senior student achieving a 26 or higher composite score on the ACT college entrance exam.
- Alan Heier Memorial Scholarship - One (1) \$200 Scholarship. Selected by teacher vote.
- Western National Bank Scholarship - One scholarship of 1,00 to a student in the top 1/2 of class for any college in Nebraska.
