

Louisville School Foundation 2022-2023 Scholarships

Earnest & Gladys Hennings Scholarship - Two (2) \$500 Scholarships. It is a needs-based scholarship, not to be awarded to top-ranked students. Looking for hard working students likely to be successful in college, with good character and work habits.

Matthew Meisinger Memorial Scholarship - One (1) \$500 Scholarship. Prefers a student planning on pursuing a vocational education of any kind (for example, mechanical/construction trades, technology, healthcare (including nursing), etc. Must be a hard-working student with firm career goals.

Lando & Eleanor Baker Scholarship - One (1) \$500 Scholarship. It is a needs-based scholarship for a student entering a technical field such as architecture, engineering or computer science.

Harry & Selma Johnson Memorial Scholarship - Two (2) \$500 Scholarships. It is a needs-based scholarship given to a student who demonstrates good character and work habits but may not be a top ranked student by GPA.

John W. Plucknett Leadership Scholarship - Recipient should be a student who meets at least 4 or the 5 following criteria points: The student exhibits outstanding leadership skills in the school setting, a good community service (of any type) record, a grade point average of 91 or above, the student was an athlete or involved in extracurricular activities, and the student is interested in majoring in business or finance.

Robert Wiesneth Memorial Scholarship - One (1) \$500 scholarship. Given to a “top” student that has taken a heavy class load of college prep advanced and online classes (physics, advanced biology & English, pre-calc.). Preference given to students that can maintain a high GPA, while being involved in school or non-school activities.

Outstanding Senior Scholarship - One (1) \$500 Scholarship. Selected by teacher vote.

Suzanne Pankonin-Lindahl Memorial Scholarship - One (1) \$300 Scholarship. Awarded to any senior student based on the merits of their application form as selected by the board of the Louisville School Foundation.

Louisville School Foundation Scholarships - \$300 Scholarship. Awarded to any senior student based on the merits of their application form as selected by the board of the Louisville School Foundation.

Louisville School Foundation ACT Scholarships - \$300 Scholarship. Awarded to any student who scores at least a 26 on the ACT and applies for this scholarship.

Alan Heier Memorial Scholarship - One (1) \$200 Scholarship. Selected by teacher vote.

Western National Bank – One (1) \$1,000 Scholarship - top 1/2 of senior class to any college in Nebraska

DYNAMITE PETE SCHOLARSHIP

1 - \$500 scholarship awarded to a graduating male student from Louisville Public High School

1 - \$500 scholarship award to a graduating female student from Louisville Public High School

This scholarship is available to a graduating senior who plans to pursue a traditional four-year university degree or technical/trade school. To be considered for the DPD scholarship students must complete and submit the criteria set forth by the application process. **In addition, the student must submit a LETTER OF RECOMMENDATION from a non-family member (i.e. teacher, coach, employer, etc.) This letter of recommendation should include statements as to why this student will be dedicated to further his/her education.**

SAM GRIGG SCHOLARSHIP (CLASS OF 2023 - 2024)

1 - \$500 scholarship awarded to a graduating senior from Louisville Public High School

This scholarship is available to a graduating senior who plans to pursue a degree in education. Awarded to a senior student based on the merits of his/her application form, resume and essays and selected by the Louisville School Foundation. If there are no eligible candidates, then the scholarship will roll over to the next year.

AGNES RICHERT SCHOLARSHIP (CLASS OF 2023-24)

1 - \$500 scholarship awarded to a graduating senior from Louisville Public High School

This scholarship is available to a graduating senior who plans to further their education by attending a traditional four-year university or technical/trade school. Looking for hard working students likely to be successful in college by demonstrating good character and work ethic. Awarded to a senior student based on the merits of his/her application form, resume and essays and selected by the Louisville School Foundation.

PHIL PANKONIN SCHOLARSHIP (CLASS OF 2023)

1 - \$400 scholarship awarded to a graduating senior from Louisville Public High School.

This scholarship is available to a graduating senior who plans to attend the University of Nebraska in Lincoln and earn a bachelor's degree in business related studies (i.e. major in Finance, Marketing, Accounting, etc.) Looking for hard working students likely to be successful in college by demonstrating good character and work ethic. Awarded to a senior student based on the merits of his/her application form, resume and essays and selected by the Louisville School Foundation. If there are no eligible candidates, then the scholarship will roll over to the next year.

LOUISVILLE CLASS OF '72 SCHOLARSHIP (CLASS OF 2023, 2024, 2025 & 2026)

1 - \$500 scholarship awarded to a graduating senior pursuing a technical/trade school degree

1 - \$500 scholarship awarded to a graduating senior pursuing a traditional 4 year degree

This scholarship is available to students who demonstrate leadership skills. Awarded to a senior student based on the merits of his/her application form, resume and essays and selected by the Louisville School Foundation.
