

2022-2023 LOUISVILLE SCHOLARSHIPS

The following scholarships are offered by local businesses or organizations. Most scholarships use the same application form; however, some have additional requirements, or a separate application so be sure to check all requirements for each scholarship you are eligible for!

Blake's Pharmacy Scholarship

A minimum of one scholarship, worth at **least \$250 will** be awarded. Criteria: 1(enrolled in college or university for one year, 2) plan on entering the health care profession, 3) maintain a GPA of 3.0 or higher. Half of the scholarship will be paid to the school for the 2nd semester of the first year, and half paid to the school once the student is enrolled for their second year.

**** Separate Essay:** What health profession do you want to enter and why? (300-500 words)

Cedar Creek Volunteer Fire Department and Auxiliary Scholarship

One \$200 scholarship will be awarded.

Derby Heating and Air Scholarship

One scholarship of at least \$250 will be awarded. Criteria: student must enroll in a trade program at a 2-year or 4-year college.

Esther M. Stohlmann Memorial Scholarship

Applicants must also complete a separate essay describing "Why I want to be a teacher"

The Lofte Theatre Scholarship

One \$350 scholarship will be awarded. Applicant must have been a Born-In-A-Barn player or volunteered at the Lofte.

Louisville Alumni Association Scholarship

Two \$100 scholarships will be awarded.

Louisville American Legion Scholarship

One \$250 scholarship will be awarded to a senior boy.

Louisville American Legion Auxiliary Scholarship

One \$250 scholarship will be awarded to a senior girl. Applicant must be accepted at a post-secondary educational institution.

Louisville Booster Scholarship

Up to four (4) scholarships will be awarded. Eligibility Criteria: must have participated in a minimum of 2 NSAA High School athletic programs for 2 years, one of which as a Senior. Minimum GPA of 88%. Parent/ guardian must be a current paid member of the LHS Athletic Booster Club. Student must complete a 400-500 word essay about how athletics, dance, and / or cheer has influenced their character. Also, two written letters of recommendation are required from an LHS coach and the other from a person in a supervisory role through community involvement or other LHS activity.

Louisville Education Association Scholarships 1) LEA Scholarship for Future Educators

A \$250 scholarship will be awarded to a student who plans on entering the field of education. Criteria: must have a GPA of 80% or better, accepted to a college in the fall and working toward a degree in education, be active in school organizations and activities, show financial need.

Louisville Scholarship for Continuing Education

A \$250 scholarship will be awarded to a student who plans to enter any accredited post-secondary (2 or 4-year college, university, tech or trade school) Criteria: must have a GPA of 80% or better, accepted to a college in the fall and working toward any degree, be active in school organizations and activities, show financial need.

Louisville Fire Department and Auxiliary Scholarship

Three \$100 scholarships will be awarded.

Louisville Foundation Scholarships (listed on Separate sheet)

Multiple scholarships are awarded each year (15 or more), not including 5 students who received the Foundation ACT Scholarship. Scholarships range from \$200-\$500.

Louisville Jaycee's Foundation Scholarship

One \$250 scholarship will be awarded.

Louisville Rod and Gun Club Scholarship

One \$500 scholarship or two \$250 scholarships will be awarded.

Patrick Cunningham Masonic Scholarship

One \$1000 scholarship will be awarded by the Euclid Lodge #97 in Weeping Water.

Pinnacle Bank Scholarship

Minimum of four \$250 scholarships will be awarded.

Matchus Scholarships

Scholarships of \$500 each for students going to any college.

Men in Mission: Christian Men's Fellowship Scholarship

Male or Female public or home school student, involved in church, strong in academics but not just tip students, strong work ethic.

Community Partners Scholarship

In this day of social media, the written note is a forgotten art. Please write a paragraph or two on one of the following topics:

Give an example of a time you recognized someone, or a time you were recognized by someone else. Hope's Closet Thrift Store Scholarship:

Two \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded.

Criteria:

- 1) Student must be enrolled in a college, university or trade program for 1 year.
- 2) Student must be planning to study social work, special education, childcare worker or entering a 2-4 year trade school program.
- 3) Student must maintain at GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- 4) Half of the scholarship will be paid for the first half of the year and the 2 nd half paid for the 2 nd semester.
- 5) Applicants must volunteer a minimum of 8 hours at Hope's Closet before April 30 th .
